0800-04 UNDERWAY AS WE HEAD INTO THE SPRAY, THE SHIP IS ENROUTE FROM SUBIC BAY. FROM THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES IS WHERE WE'VE COME, BACK TO THE LINE AFTER HAVING OUR FUN. AS THE NAVIGATOR KEEPS TRACK OF ALL OUR LOCATIONS, WE ARE SAILING ON FOR SOME SPECIAL OPERATIONS. TO THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH VIETNAM WE ARE STEAMING, OF WHAT LIES AHEAD ALL ARE DREAMING. OPERATING WITH TG-76.5 ARE WE, CLEARING OUR WAY THROUGH THE SOUTH CHINA SEA. OTC AND SOPA IS CAPT. J.D. WESTERVELT, (U.S.N.), HE CAN HANDLE IT AND ALL IS WELL. FOLLOWING HIS ORDERS AS WE STEAM, OTC AND SOPA IS ABOARD THE USS IWOJIMA (LPH-2). NUMBER ONE IS OUR FORMATION, AND THOUGH ITS NEW YEARS EVE THERE IS NO ROTATION.
